**Rocky Mountain
Diversity Legal Career Fair**

We are pleased to announce the return of the Rocky Mountain Diversity Legal Career Fair. This year's fair will again be held at Invesco Field at Mile High in Denver, Colorado, on Friday, September 17, 2010. The goal of the fair is to promote a format that enables Rocky Mountain region employers, including law firms of all sizes, corporations, public interest organizations and government agencies and organizations, to meet and interview a diverse group of law students and recent graduates. Again this year, the fair will be open to students and recent graduates from any U.S. law school.

We gratefully acknowledge your past support of the Career Fair. Your financial assistance laid the groundwork so that hundreds of students and recent graduates from all over the country registered to meet over 30 employers. Without your help, past Career Fairs would not have succeeded.

Last year we recognized that there was great uncertainty in our economy. While many have weathered 2009, there continues to be economic ambiguity. Accordingly, we have reconfigured the RMDLCF for 2010 so that it will be more attractive to our employers while still offering opportunities to the candidates. The primary changes are:

- Interviews will run one-half day in the morning instead of a full day.
- We will not host the Employer Expo and lunch.
- In addition to posting traditional job openings for entry level or summer associate positions, employers may choose to conduct informational interviews. This would allow employers who may not have any job openings at the time of the fair to provide students with information about their organizations and to interview candidates for potential openings in the future. This would also give the students the opportunity to meet employers. Employers will identify in their job posting whether their interviews are informational or traditional.



- Sponsorship levels have been cut significantly in 2010 so that employers may continue to demonstrate their support for diversity in a difficult economy.

We have attached a list of sponsorship opportunities for the 2010 Rocky Mountain Diversity Legal Career Fair, which we hope you will consider as you plan for your upcoming recruiting season.
